Subject: Case No. PU-25-172, ONEOK Tioga Extension Project, Condition No. 34 Notice

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Per our Order, Condition No. 34., “Company shall notify the Commission as soon as reasonably possible if any damage, as defined by North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-23, occurs to underground facilities during construction conducted under the certificate or permit issued in this proceeding. In the event of any damage to underground facilities. Company shall suspend construction in the vicinity of the damage until compliance with One-Call Excavation Notice System requirements under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-23 has been determined.”

On behalf of ONEOK, I am providing the following notice regarding an incident involving underground facilities of the R&T Water District.

On 9.26.2025 at approximately 11:29 am, ONEOK’s Tioga Extension Project (Project) construction contractor received a call from R&T Water District regarding a water outage. The Project’s horizontal directional drilling (HDD) subcontractor was immediately notified and stopped work at the HDD across 74th Street NW, which has a R&T Water District water line crossing. HDD operations at this location were suspended.

R&T Water District personnel came out to the work site to investigate. R&T Water District confirmed that water pressure had dropped on a 2-inch water line that feeds Argent/Silver Hill facility. Given the water line’s depth below ground surface at this location, R&T District is planning to install a replacement section of water line via HDD or boring.

ONEOK and the R&T Water District are collaborating on next steps and drill design/path for each company’s respective HDDs.

ONEOK’s contractor determined that the One-Call rules were followed leading up to construction and during this incident today. ONEOK’s contractor had obtained One-Call tickets and coordinated with R&T Water District regarding the location and depth of this water line. The Project holds an R&T Water District crossing permit to install the Project pipeline at this location.
