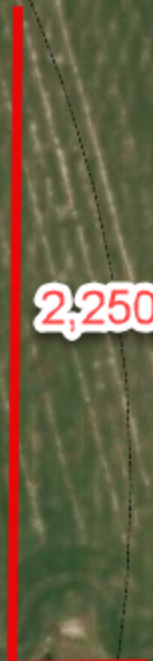
Proposed Site

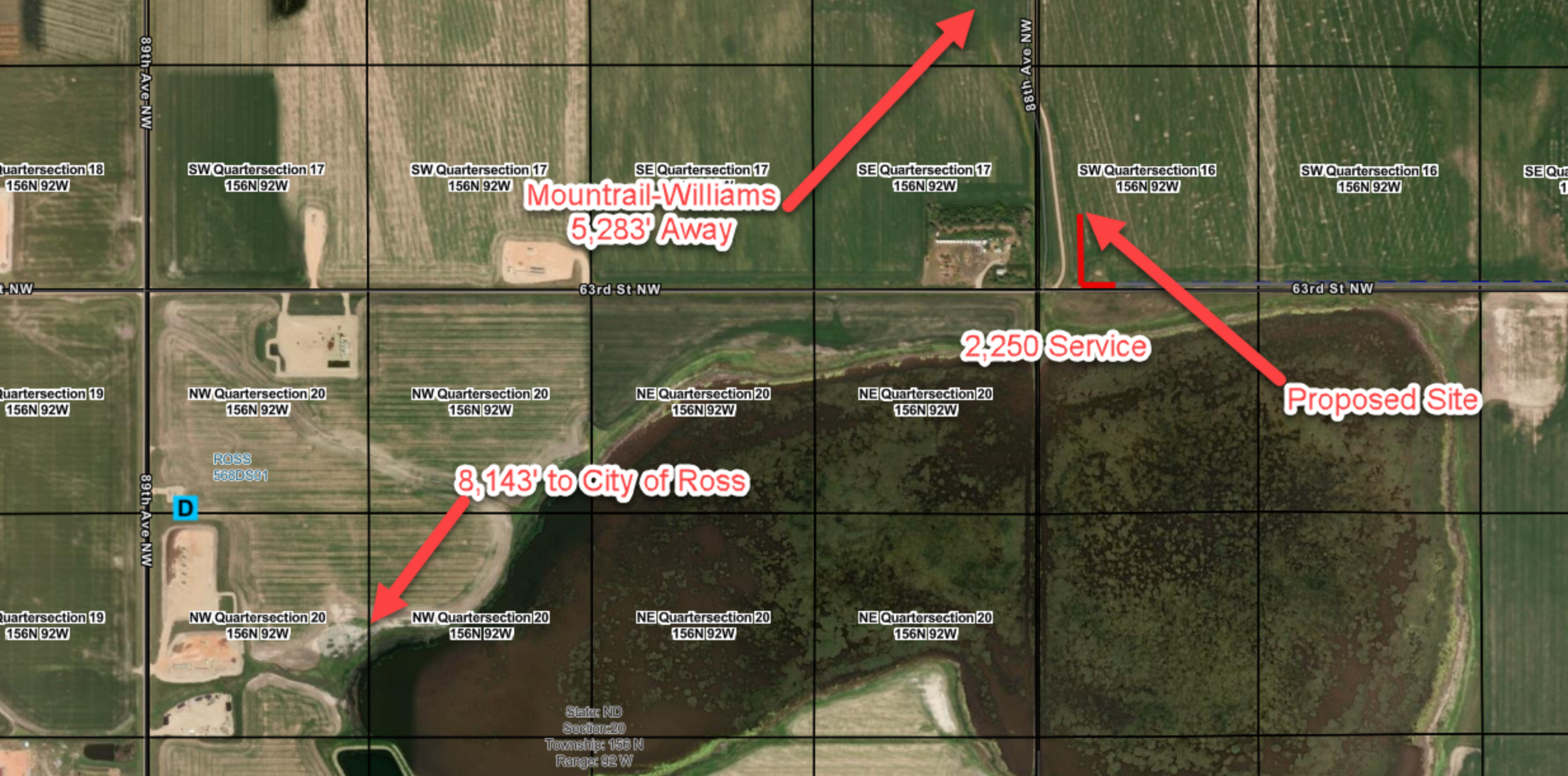
