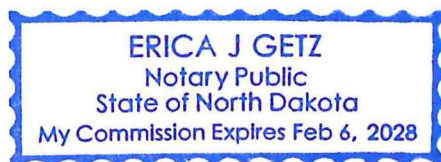

A **Public Hearing** on the application in Case No. PU-25-209 is scheduled for **November 20, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Central Time at the Emmons County Courthouse Auditorium, 100 4th Street NW, Linton, ND 58552.**

On June 18, 2025, Emmons-Logan Energy Storage, LLC (Emmons) filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility concerning the location for a 140 megawatt battery energy storage system (Project) in Emmons County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed Project produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Is the proposed Project compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed Project location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
