Reminder – file CAF ICC data with your state commission by June 16

To: General and pool contacts at TS and SW pool

[Part 54.304\(d\)\(1\)](#) of FCC rules requires rate-of-return carriers seeking CAF ICC support to file data with the relevant state commissions by the date of our annual access tariff filing.

Annual tariff filing date is June 16, 2025

We are filing the interstate tariff with the FCC on Monday, June 16, 2025. Concurrent with the annual tariff filing, we will file your CAF ICC data with USAC. Therefore, you should file your CAF ICC data with your state commissions no later than June 16. To assist you with that process, the following reports are available on our [website](#) (login required; select Member Services > Data Collections and Tools > CAF ICC Data Collection):

- **Intrastate TRP report** displays the proposed July 1, 2025 intrastate tariff at the rate element level.
- **Post-true-up access recovery charge output report** has the proposed residential ARC, revenue and lines at the exchange level, as well as the proposed ARC, revenue and lines for SLB and MLB at the study area level.
- **USAC report** displays the post-true-up CAF ICC amount and final CAF ICC support estimate labeled "Adjusted CAF ICC Support," which has been reduced by imputed ARC revenues on broadband-only lines.




