NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR CONSOLIDATED HEARING

On June 18, 2025, in Case No. PU-24-351 the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Site Compatibility Number 70 to Flickertail Solar Project, LLC for the construction, operation and maintenance of an up to 300 MW solar energy conversion facility located in Abercrombie Township in Richland County, North Dakota.

On July 8, 2025, Flickertail Solar Project, LLC (Flickertail) and Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) filed a joint application to transfer the Certificate of Site Compatibility number 70 from Flickertail to Otter Tail. (Case No. PU-25-220)

Also on July 8, 2025, Otter Tail filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the Abercrombie Solar Project, a 291.5 MW solar generation facility located in Abercrombie Township, Richland County, North Dakota (Case No. PU-25-221).

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-25-220 are:

1. Whether Otter Tail agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Certificate of Site Compatibility Number 70.
2. Whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-25-221 are:

1. Whether public convenience and necessity will be served by construction and operation of the facility.
2. Is Otter Tail technically, financially, and managerially fit and able to provide the service?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must**

be received by **September 16, 2025**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
