


Submitted with the application was a statement by Badger Wind, LLC desiring electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:


**Section 08, Township 132N, Range 71W in McIntosh County, North Dakota**


Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.
