**LTE Wireless Inc.
CERTIFICATION RELATING TO ORDER PROVISIONS**

I am Faizel Hassad, a representative of LTE Wireless Inc. (LTE) with authority to bind LTE and I certify that:

1. LTE is seeking designation as a Lifeline-Only Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (Lifeline-Only ETC) for all non-rural telephone company wire centers within the state of North Dakota, all rural telephone company study areas within the state of North Dakota, and all Tribal areas within the non-rural and rural telephone company areas within the state of North Dakota, which is the entire state of North Dakota.
2. For the telephone exchanges enumerated, LTE understands and agrees to the conditions and criteria set forth in Chapter 49-21 of the North Dakota Century Code and Chapter 69-09-05 of the North Dakota Administrative Code that pertain to Lifeline-Only Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (Lifeline Only ETC) , and LTE will be responsible for compliance with this Certification, the Public Service Commission's order in this proceeding, and conditions and criteria set forth in the applicable federal and state laws and rules pertaining to Lifeline-Only ETCs.
3. LTE agrees to comply with all statements, processes and procedures set forth in its Application for designation as a Lifeline-Only ETC in the enumerated telephone exchanges. LTE agrees that all statements made and matters set forth in its Application are true and correct to the best of LTE's knowledge, information, and belief.
4. LTE will use the federal low-income universal service support it receives only for the provision of services for which the support is intended.
5. LTE meets all of the prerequisites to be designated as a Lifeline-Only ETC throughout the proposed ETC Designated Area in this proceeding.
6. LTE provides each of the services supported by federal universal service support mechanisms, specified in Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) rules, 47 C.F.R. § 54.101, and will offer these supported services in North Dakota upon designation as a Lifeline-Only ETC, including voice grade access, minutes of use for local service at no additional charge, access to emergency services and toll limitation services.


7. LTE will provide service on a timely basis to requesting customers within the applicant's proposed designated service area where the applicant's network already passes the potential customer's premises.
8. LTE will provide service within a reasonable period of time, if the potential customer is within LTE's proposed designated service area but outside its existing network coverage, if service can be provided at reasonable cost by:
 - (a) Modifying or replacing the requesting customer's equipment;
 - (d) Adjusting network or customer facilities; or
 - (e) Reselling services from another carrier's facilities to provide service.
9. LTE will not seek Universal Service Fund high-cost support for any telephone exchanges in its designated service area in North Dakota.
10. LTE will use all available means to ensure customers are eligible for the Lifeline program at the time of sign-up and recertification in accordance with the federal eligibility criteria in 47 C.F.R. § 54.409 and the relevant proof documentation specified in 47 C. F. R. § 54.410. LTE will check all available databases including the National Lifeline Accountability Database to prevent duplication and determine eligibility.
11. LTE has taken, and will continue to take, steps to work with its underlying carriers to remain functional in emergency situations by: (1) maintaining a reasonable amount of backup power to ensure functionality without an external power source; (2) maintaining the ability to re-route traffic around damaged facilities and to manage traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations; and (3) establishing procedures for employees to follow In an emergency to prevent or minimize interruption or impairment of telecommunications services.
12. LTE will meet or exceed applicable consumer protection and quality standards and will comply with the Cellular Telecommunications and Internet Association's (CTIA) Consumer Code for Wireless Service
13. LTE will advertise the availability of the supported services detailed in its Application, and the corresponding rates and charges, in a manner designed to inform the general public within North Dakota. This advertising will occur through a combination of media channels, such as television and radio, newspaper, magazine and other print advertisements, outdoor advertising, direct marketing, and the Internet.
14. LTE will offer the services described in its Application.
15. LTE understands and agrees that if LTE has not advertised its Lifeline services or signed up any North Dakota customers within 12 months of the effective date of LTE's designation as a Lifeline-only ETC, the Public Service Commission may revoke LTE's Lifeline-only ETC designation and North American may reapply to be designated as a Lifeline-only ETC In North Dakota.
16. LTE will comply with all applicable annual reporting requirements associated with

being an ETC in North Dakota including filing with the Public Service Commission a copy of each report filed with the FCC, within 30 days of filing with the FCC.

17. LTE understands and agrees that its ability to offer service is subject to suspension or revocation for failure to comply with the Public Service Commission's orders, or applicable statutes, rules, regulations, standards, and other authorizations.
18. LTE agrees to maintain the records to demonstrate that LTE has complied with the requirements of the Public Service Commission's order(s) and that LTE will preserve records demonstrating compliance for Public Service Commission inspection at any reasonable time upon reasonable notice.
19. LTE understands and agrees that, to the extent there are any conflicts or inconsistencies between LTE's Application and the provisions in this Certification, the Certification provisions control.
