I am sending you this information so that you are aware of the complaint and may respond with information concerning the complaint. **Please respond to Executive Secretary, North Dakota Public Service Commission, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Dept 408, Bismarck, ND 58505-0480 by March 4, 2026**, with your written account of the event, including the applicable One-Call locate ticket number(s) for work performed at the location identified in the complaint and in connection with the enclosed complaint.

Your response and the North Dakota One-Call Complaint will be reviewed to determine whether there may be a violation of the One-Call Excavation Notice System law.

If I do not receive a response by the date noted, I will determine whether there was a violation without your side of the story, based on the facts contained in this complaint. If I conclude a violation did occur, I will file with the Commission a formal complaint against Extreme Underground HDD LLC which may result in a civil penalty up to \$25,000 per violation in accordance with North Dakota Century Code Section 49-07-01.1.

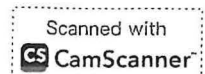

Description of the alleged violation/concern. If more space is required, attach additional page(s). While boring electrical power lines for MDU, Extreme Boring bored through my sewer pipe. I had no knowledge of this until Watford City Public Works reached out to tell me my sewer line was damaged. They ran a camera from the sewer main line in the road, and the MDU electrical line is currently running through my sewer line. This happened back in August 2023 and was never reported. To my knowledge, we were never contacted to mark any utilities. I reached out to MDU, Extreme Boring, Watford City, and ND One Call for answers.

Good Morning,

My Name is Red Morvan with Prairie Heights Apartments in Watford City, ND. I have attached a complaint form regarding an issue I have at my apartment complex.

A contractor bored an electrical line through my sewer line. I was informed of this issue by Watford City Public Works Department back on 8/18/25. After some research, I discovered that MDU hired Extreme Boring to perform the work in question. I contacted both companies and they are not accepting responsibility. I also spoke with Justin Smith (Watford City Engineer) several times and had a meeting in his office. I also spoke with several people at ND One Call. Ryan Schmaltz is the Director of Education/PR and after numerous conversations he said I should file a complaint.

This damage occurred back in August of 2023. I have read the ND Century Code and I think the contractor should be liable for damages. The estimate I received was \$44,000 for repairs. My sewer was working perfectly fine before the contractor caused these damages.

I look forward to hearing back from your office.
