Pursuant to North Dakota Administrative Code (“NDAC”) § 69-02-09-01, Homestead Wind, LLC (“Homestead Wind”) submits this application to protect from disclosure certain confidential information filed with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) in the above-captioned matter. The purpose of this application for protection of information is to protect from public disclosure cultural resource location information pursuant to North Dakota Century Code (“NDCC”) § 49-22-26 (“The [C]ommission may limit access to, and release of, information that contains data that specifically identifies the location of cultural, archaeological, historical, or paleontological sites.”).

Specifically, Homestead Wind requests that protection be given to the cultural resource location information contained on pages 5-2, 5-3, 6-6, 6-21, 7-4, 7-7, 7-8, and Figure 5-1 of the *Class III Cultural Resource Survey of the Homestead Wind Project*, along with associated GIS data. Specifically, Homestead Wind requests that the information be available only to the Commission, the Commission’s counsel, the Commission’s siting analysts, and the Administrative Law Judge.

Two (2) hard copies of the unredacted, nonpublic version of the *Class III Cultural Resource Survey of the Homestead Wind Project* are being provided with this request. Also provided is a USB drive containing nonpublic GIS data. The redacted public version of the *Class III Cultural*

Resource Survey of the Homestead Wind Project is provided as Appendix H.2 to Homestead Wind's Application for a Certificate of Site Compatibility, filed concurrently.
