NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing on the application in Case No. PU-26-86 is scheduled for **September 29, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. Central Time at the Grand Williston Hotel & Conference Center, 3601 Second Avenue West, Williston, ND 58801.**

On March 4, 2026, Homestead Wind, LLC (Homestead Wind) filed an application for a Certificate of Site Compatibility to construct an up-to 256.5-megawatt Homestead Wind Project consisting of up to 67 wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Williams County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facilities' locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

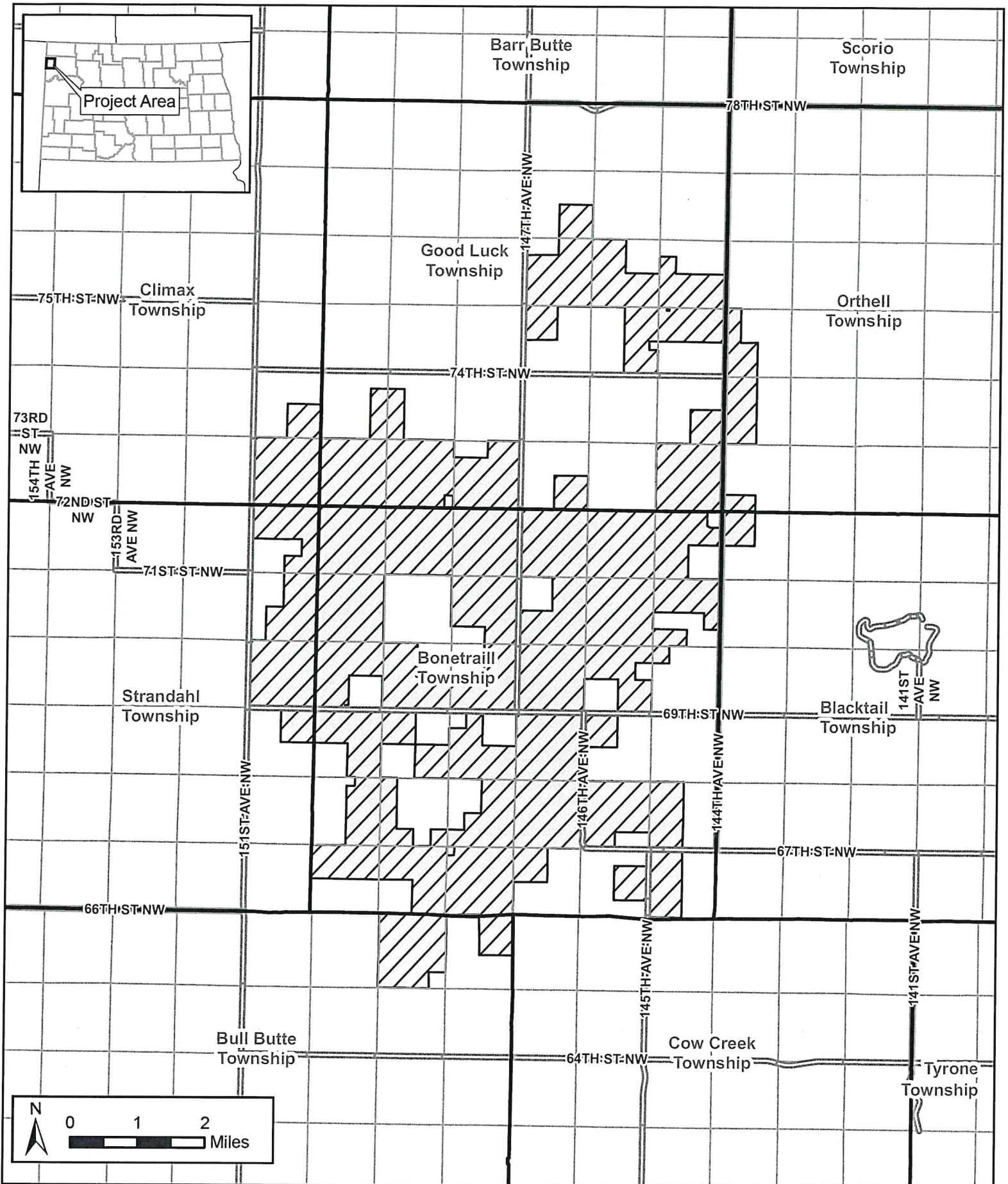
