NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing on the application in Case No. PU-26-164 is scheduled for August 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. Central Time at the Sleep Inn & Suites Conference Center and Water Park, 2400 10th Street SW, Minot, ND 58701.

On August 12, 2009, the Commission issued its Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order in Case No. PU-08-75, granting Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 14 for Basin Electric Power Cooperative (Basin) to construct a wind facility comprised of 77 turbines with a capacity of up to 115.5 megawatts (MW).

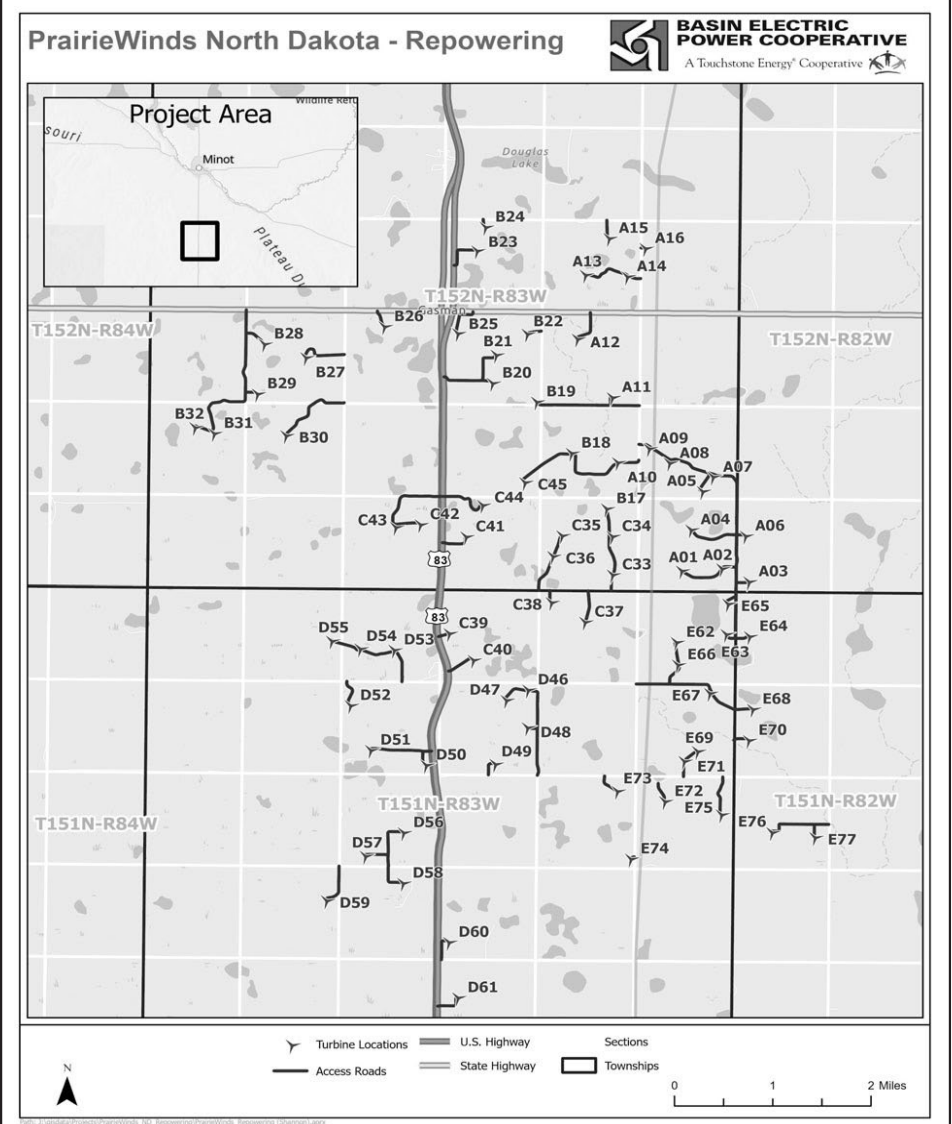
On May 1, 2026, Basin filed an application with the Public Service Commission for a siting application to amend the 2009 Order and Certificate to remove the 1.5 MW per turbine and the 115.5 MW facility restrictions. Basin proposes to remove the existing turbines and upgrade them to 1.6 MW turbines with a total facility capacity of up to 128 MWs. The project will not affect the layout or expand the site boundary. The project is located in Ward County approximately 24 miles due south of Minot, ND and is shown on the attached map.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Will the construction, operation, and maintenance of the proposed facility at the proposed location produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the construction, operation, and maintenance of the proposed facility at the proposed location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

ATTENTION ALL PROPERTY OWNERS CITY OF MINOT NOTICE TO CUT TALL WEEDS OR GRASS

Property owners in the City of Minot are required to mow weeds or grass, before they exceed 8 inches tall, Under Chapter 22 (Nuisances) of the City of Minot Code of Ordinances.

If the tall weeds or grass on a property is determined to be in excess of 8 inches tall, such weeds or grass must be cut within 48 hours. Additional exemptions are outlined in City Ordinance section 22-9. Otherwise, the City of Minot will arrange for cutting; and the cost of such work will be assessed against the property. No further notice to individual property owners is required under Chapter 22. NOTICE TO RUSHVILLE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

Notice is hereby given that the County Commissioners of the County of Ward, North Dakota, is now requiring all landowners of Rushville Township to mow the township road ditches adjacent to their property and comply with the following criteria. Landowners must complete the cutting no later than October 1st of each year.

All grass and weed cuttings must be in the ditch of the roadway and not on the gravel road surface.

The height of stubble left shall be no taller than 6-inches in height. Minimum width of cut for each side of the roadway is 10 feet.

The following roads in Rushville Township are required to be mowed: 30th St. SW, 317th Ave. SW, 331st Ave. SW, 16th St. SW, 345th Ave. SW, 373rd Ave. SW, 359th Ave. SE, 317th Ave. SE, 27th St. SE, 303 Ave. SE.

If the adjacent landowner fails to mow the ditches of the roadway as outlined above and/or leaves cuttings on the road top, the County will mow/ remove cuttings from the roadway and assess all expenses against the land of the landowner and shall become a part of the taxes levied against the land for the ensuing year.
