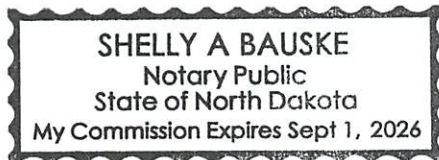

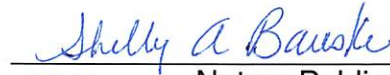

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On June 18, 2026, Otter Tail Power Company filed an application for petition for approval of Tiered Large General Service. The proposed changes modify the existing Large General Service class into tiers while proposing a new classification and rate schedule for very large customers.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Are the proposed tariff revisions just and reasonable?
2. Do the proposed rates comply with the tariff?
3. Are the proposed rates just and reasonable?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by September 7, 2026.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.

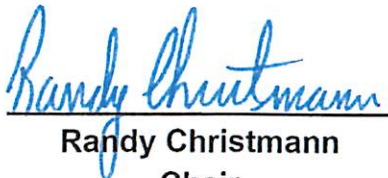
