Comments:

The extension will serve temporary construction power for APDL BIS-01 LLC west of Center, ND. Because this load is temporary, Montana-Dakota intends to collect the extension cost from the customer as a CIAC. Montana-Dakota has a 115 KV line on the Southwest Corner of the property and we believe the Coop would need to extend service approximately 3 miles to the site to meet the power needs. Both Montana-Dakota and the Coop would have approximately 16,000 feet of additional primary within the site to serve all the customer's temporary construction meter locations.

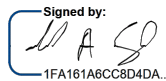
