Pursuant to NDCC Chapter 49-22 and NDAC Article 69-06, Dakota Gasification Company ("DGC") respectfully submits this Application for a transfer of the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility issued to DGC for the Natural Gas Pipeline project in Case No. PU-13-22

B. Statutory Provisions

Transfer of a certificate of site compatibility is authorized under NDCC § 49-22-07 and NDAC § 69-06-01-02(3). Pursuant to these provisions, the Commission shall hold a public hearing on an application for the transfer of a certificate, if, following publication of a notice of opportunity for a public hearing in the official newspaper in the County in which the facility is located, an interested person requests and demonstrates good

cause for a public hearing, or the Commission upon its own motion determines there is good cause for a public hearing.

C. Background

By Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order dated July 10, 2013, Case No. PU-13-22, the Commission issued a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Certificate Number 142 and Route Permit Number 155 to DGC for the 3.5 mile, ten-inch diameter natural gas pipeline ("Project") from Basin Electric Power Cooperative's ("Basin Electric") Antelope Valley Station to an interconnection with DGC's plant site in Mercer County, North Dakota.

D. Application for Transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility

DGC now submits this application for a transfer of the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit issued to DGC in Case No. PU-13-22 to Basin Electric. In support thereof, DGC and Basin Electric state as follows:

1. DGC is a North Dakota corporation duly authorized to do business in North Dakota.
2. Basin Electric is a corporation duly authorized to do business in the State of North Dakota, which certificate of good standing is attached and is incorporated herein by reference.
3. This application is made pursuant to the provisions of NDCC § 49-22-7, NDCC 49-22-13(2) and NDAC §§ 69-06-01-02(3).
4. The Commission's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in its July 10, 2013 Order issuing the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit to DGC in Case No. PU-13-22 constitutes a sufficient legal basis for the transfer of the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit to Basin Electric, after the Commission having concluded, among other things: the Project was of such a design, location and purpose that it will produce minimal adverse effects as defined by NDCC § 49-22-05.2; the application submitted by DGC met the site evaluation criteria required by NDCC Chapter 49-22; the location, construction,

and operation of the Project will produce only minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota; the Project is compatible with environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources; and the Project will minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion.

5. If such transfer is approved, while Basin Electric will own the Project, DGC will operate the Project.

WHEREFORE, DGC and Basin Electric respectfully request that the Commission, following publication of a notice of opportunity for a public hearing in the official newspaper in the county in Mercer County and, unless there is both a request by an interested person and a showing of good cause:

1. Grant to DGC and Basin Electric without hearing, a transfer to Basin Electric of the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 142 and Route Permit No. 155 issued in Case No. PU-13-22 for all of the rights and obligations of the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit.
2. Grant such other relief as the Commission shall deem appropriate.

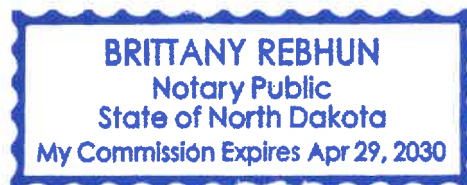
