**NOTICE OF NAME CHANGE AND
REQUEST FOR REISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE AND PERMIT**

On December 3, 1997, in Case No. PU-593-96-11, the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approved the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Dakota Gasification Company (“DGC”) a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 73 (“Certificate”) and on December 31, 1998, issued Route Permit No. 84 (“Permit”) for an approximate 167-mile 14-inch/12-inch diameter carbon dioxide pipeline originating in Mercer County, North Dakota (“Pipeline”). The Pipeline originates at DGC’s Great Plains Synfuels Plant. The route proceeds west to a point north of Dunn Center, North Dakota and then traverses northwest around the Killdeer Mountains and across the Little Missouri River. It then generally proceeds north under Lake Sakakawea through portions of McKenzie, Williams, and Divide Counties, North Dakota. At a point south of Noonan, North Dakota, the route angles to the northwest to the Canadian border just north of Crosby, North Dakota. Through the undersigned counsel, notice is hereby provided that the Pipeline owned and operated by Dakota Gasification Company underwent a name change and is now known as Roughrider Pipeline, LLC (“Roughrider”). The rest of DGC’s assets remain unchanged.

The Certificate and Permit remain held by the original permittee Dakota Gasification Company. Dakota Gasification Company respectfully requests the Certificate and Permit be transferred and reissued to Roughrider Pipeline, LLC. Roughrider Pipeline, LLC is a wholly owned subsidiary of Dakota Gasification Company. In support of this request, attached hereto are copies of certificates of good standing from the North Dakota and Delaware Secretaries of State.

Roughrider Pipeline, LLC submits it is appropriate for the Certificate and Permit to be updated and reissued consistent with its transfer, and that a transfer application, public notice, and public hearing are not applicable to this request. The provisions of N.D.C.C Ch. 49-22.1 pertaining to certificate and permit transfers govern the transfer of siting certificates and permits between separate and distinct entities, and do not apply or govern the name change of an existing permittee. For these reasons, Roughrider Pipeline, LLC respectfully requests the Commission transfer and reissue Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 73 and Route Permit No. 84 in the name of Roughrider Pipeline, LLC, without publication of notice or public hearing.
