**NOTICE OF NAME CHANGE AND
REQUEST FOR REISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE AND PERMIT**

On August 31, 2026, in Case No. PU-26-296, the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) via motion approved the First Reissued Certificate of Coordinator Compatibility No. 73 and First Reissued Route Permit No. 84 to Roughrider Pipeline, LLC for the approximately 167-mile carbon dioxide pipeline originating at Dakota Gasification Company’s Great Plains Synfuels Plant.

Inadvertently omitted from that request was the inclusion of a transfer of the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 97 and Route Permit No. 107, issued to Dakota Gasification Company (“DGC”) by the Commission in Case No. PU-07-184 on June 27, 2007. The Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order in Case No. PU-07-184 provided that “DGC testified that it would be prudent to improve the pipeline’s crossing of Lake Sakakawea. Given the protracted drought conditions in the Upper Missouri River watershed, coupled with the management of the reservoir by the United States Corps of Engineers (COE), the level of the reservoir has dropped 30 feet since the pipeline was installed in the year 1999. Specifically, DGC is concerned the pipeline may become exposed and could become a hazard to the public.”

Dakota Gasification Company respectfully requests that the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 97 and Route Permit No. 107, also be transferred and reissued to Roughrider Pipeline, LLC, similar to what was previously done in Case No. PU-26-296.

Roughrider Pipeline, LLC is a wholly owned subsidiary of Dakota Gasification Company. In support of this request, attached hereto are copies of certificates of good standing from the North Dakota and Delaware Secretaries of State.

Roughrider Pipeline, LLC submits it is appropriate for the Certificate and Permit to be updated and reissued consistent with its transfer, and that a transfer application, public notice, and public hearing are not applicable to this request. The provisions of N.D.C.C Ch. 49-22.1 pertaining to certificate and permit transfers govern the transfer of siting certificates and permits between separate and distinct entities, and do not apply or govern the name change of an existing permittee. For these reasons, Roughrider Pipeline, LLC respectfully requests the Commission transfer and reissue Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 97 and Route Permit No. 107 in the name of Roughrider Pipeline, LLC, without publication of notice or public hearing.
