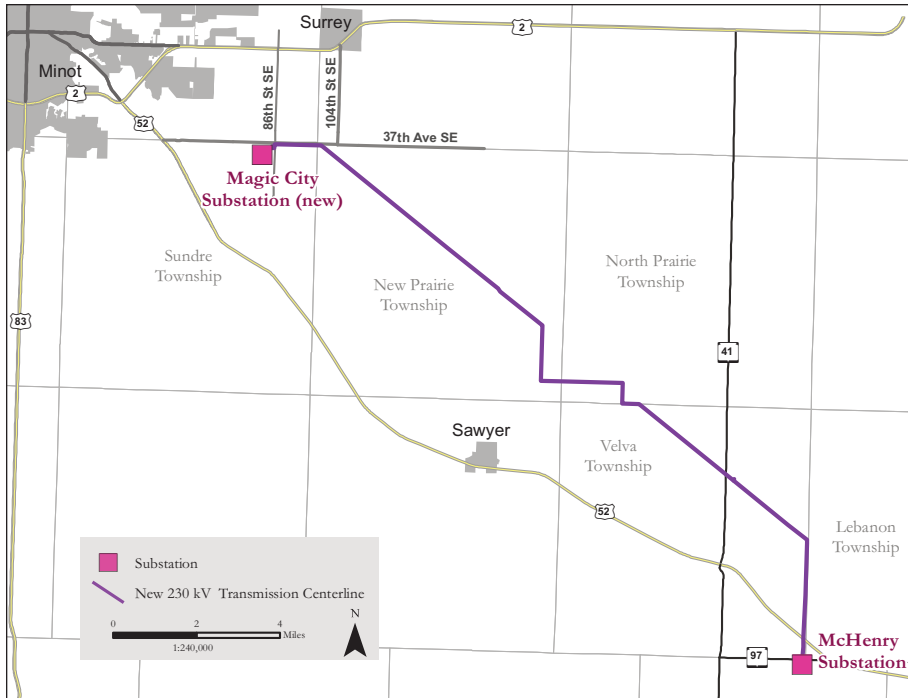
Please Join Us

Celebrate completion of the new Magic City-McHenry transmission line project which will provide enhanced electric reliability in Minot and the region by adding an additional electricity source for customers. The 20-mile transmission line runs between the existing McHenry Substation near Velva and the new Magic City Substation in Minot. Construction on the nearly \$50 million project began in 2017.

The new single pole double circuit 230/115 kilovolt (kV) transmission line will replace the existing 115 kV line that was built over 60 years ago. Removal of the old H-frame structures will begin in late 2018.

Xcel Energy collaborated with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Partners for Wildlife program to plant 40 acres of pollinator habitat around the new substation in May. The native plants which include nearly two dozen different wildflowers are beneficial to pollinators including the monarch butterfly, bees and birds.
