PSC Schedules Public Hearing for Proposed Solar Project in Richland County

BISMARCK, ND – The North Dakota Public Service Commission (PSC) will hold a public hearing on Monday, March 24, regarding an application for a siting permit for a solar energy conversion facility in Richland County.

Flickertail Solar Project, LLC, (a wholly owned subsidiary of Savion, LLC) is requesting a siting permit for the construction of a 300-megawatt solar energy conversion facility. The proposed project would be located on approximately 3,464 acres north of Galchutt, N.D. Estimated cost of the project is \$375 million.

Information received after the hearing will not be part of the official record and cannot be used as a basis for the Commission's decision unless certain additional procedures are followed.

The North Dakota Public Service Commission is a constitutionally created state agency with authority to permit, site and regulate certain business activities in the state including electric and gas utilities, telecommunications companies, power plants, electric transmission lines, pipelines, railroads, commercial weighing devices, pipeline safety and coal mine reclamation.
